Tabla Rasa Gallery is pleased to present a screening of EVERY MOTHER'S SON, on Saturday, May 18, 2019 at 2:00 PM. The film was produced and directed by Tami Gold and Kelly Anderson. Ms. Gold will be present for a Q&A following the screening, which is FREE and open to the public. Tabla Rasa is located at 224 48th Street between 2nd and 3rd Avenues, in Brooklyn.

EVERY MOTHER'S SON is about three ordinary mothers forced to become extraordinary activists after their sons were killed by the police - is powerful, heartbreaking, and ultimately transforming. This is the story of their sons' lives and deaths, told through the hearts and minds of their mothers. The film transforms victims into real people and makes it impossible to remain indifferent or inactive about the issue of police misconduct and excessive use of force. The stories, originally completed and broadcast in 2004, remain relevant to policing and race issues to this day.

Anthony Raymond Baez was killed during a pick-up football game on the streets of the Bronx, when a police officer put him in a stranglehold after accusing the group of being a gang. Amadou Diallo was unarmed when he was killed by four police officers who shot at him 41 times in the doorway of his apartment building. Gary (Gidone) Busch was pepper sprayed, surrounded and then shot to death by police while holding a small inscribed hammer, even though witnesses at the scene said it was clear he posed no threat to the officers.

EVERY MOTHER'S SON won the Tribeca Film Festival Audience Award, the Cine Golden Eagle Award, was nominated for an EMMY and broadcast on the PBS series POV. Tami Gold has been on WABC, NPR and PBS addressing Stop and Frisk and other related issues. EVERY MOTHER'S SON continues to screen at film festivals internationally and is a major work used in Criminal Justice programs.
